MOTION TO INVEST THE FUNDS OF THE RECEIVERSHIP
COMPANIES AND BRIEF IN SUPPORT

Thomas S. Richey, as Receiver for Weston Rutledge Financial Services, Inc.; Zamindari Capital, LLC; Lexington International Fund, LLC, a/k/a Lexington International Fund, Inc.; and Oxford Adams Capital, LLC (the “Receivership Companies”) (the “Receiver”), through his undersigned counsel hereby requests permission to invest funds of the Receivership Companies in order to maximize the value of the Receivership Estate.¹ The Receiver requests permission to invest all

or any part of the funds of the Receivership Companies in deposit accounts or certificates of deposit which are fully insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or another agency of the United States government, short-term securities issued or fully guaranteed by the United States government, or federal funds.

Pursuant to the Court's Order of May 17, 2006 and as re-affirmed in the Court's Order of June 30, 2006, the Receiver is charged with the duty and power to "manage, control, operate and maintain the Receiver Estate." In order to effectively maintain the funds of the Receivership Companies, the Receiver requests that the Receiver be permitted to invest all or any part of the funds of the Receivership Companies in deposit accounts or certificates of deposit which are fully insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or another agency of the United States government, short-term securities issued or fully guaranteed by the United States government, or federal funds.

This Court has the power to direct the Receiver to invest the funds of the Receivership Companies. See Bookout v. Atlas Financial Corp., 395 F. Supp. 1338, 1344 (N.D. Ga. 1974). In Bookout, this Court approved a broad investment plan for a Receiver to "invest [receivership funds] in interest bearing accounts or certificates of deposit issued by a National Bank." The Receiver's request is an

investment request similar to the investment approved in Bookout. Therefore, the Receiver requests that this Court grant the Motion to Invest the Receivership Funds. (See Proposed Order, attached hereto).
