ORDER CONVERTING CASE

The Debtor in the above-styled case filed a Motion to Convert from Chapter 11 to Chapter 7 on October 17, 2007; therefore pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §1112(a), it is hereby

ORDERED that the case is converted from a Chapter 11 proceeding to one under Chapter 7, and the U. S. Trustee is directed to appoint a Chapter 7 Trustee immediately; it is further

ORDERED that within thirty days of the date of entry of this order, or on or before the 11 U.S.C. §341 meeting of creditors scheduled in the converted Chapter 7 case, the debtor shall file a schedule of current income, current expenditures and the statement of intention required by 11 U.S.C. §521(1) and (2); and it is further

ORDERED that, pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1019(5), the debtor in the superceded Chapter 11 case shall file and serve upon the U. S. Trustee the following: (1) within fifteen (15) days of the date of entry of this Order, a schedule of all unpaid debts incurred after the commencement of the superceded Chapter 11 case; and (2) within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of this Order, a final report and account including the name and address of each creditor. It is further

ORDERED that professionals employed by the debtor in the Chapter 11 case are hereby directed to file, within thirty days of the entry of this Order, an application for compensation of fees and expenses incurred during the Chapter 11 administration or, alternatively, to immediately turn over to the appointed Chapter 7 trustee any pre-petition deposit or fee advance ("retainer") for which allowance has not been made by the entry of a court order.
