DEFAULT JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT DERRICK TELLING

Plaintiff's Request for Entry of Default Judgment as to Defendant Derrick Telling ("Telling") having come before this Court and the same having been read and considered, Defendant Telling by his Default have admitted and the Court hereby finds as follows:

1. Defendant Telling was served by publication beginning April 7, 2008 through May 5, 2008 informing him that his answer to the Complaint was due on or before May 19, 2008. Defendant Telling failed to answer and therefore default was entered against him on June 25, 2008.

2. The Complaint sought \$615,000 from Defendant 668,195.45
\$117.94/day from May 18, 2007 and therefore t
certain.
3. The total principal amount sued for is \$615,000 plus \$53,195.45 of interest
accrued from May 18, 2007, the date of the Receiver's demand for the
return of the funds, to August 11, 2008, the date of the Request for Default
Judgment.
4. Plaintiff is also entitled to \$ 53,195.45 [**\$117.94 x number of days**],
representing the amount of interest accrued from August 11, 2008, the date
of the Request for Default Judgment, to the date of this Order.
5. There is no just reason for delaying the entry of a final judgment as to
Defendant Telling and as to the claims against him.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed that a default
judgment be entered against Defendant Telling for \$ 668,195.45 [**\$615,000**
+ \$53,195.45, accrued interest as of August 11, 2008, the date of the Request]
+ [interest accrued from August 11, 2008 to the date of this Order]. It is
further ordered that interest shall accrue on this judgment at the maximum rate
allowed by law, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961.
