DEFAULT JUDGMENT AS TO DEFENDANT ANTONIO MARIA RUSPOLI

Plaintiff's Request for Entry of Default Judgment as to Defendant Antonio Maria Ruspoli having come before this Court and the same having been read and considered, Defendant Ruspoli by his Default has admitted and the Court hereby finds as follows:

1. Defendant Ruspoli was served by publication beginning March 16, 2009 through April 5, 2009 informing him that his answer to the Complaint was due on or before May 5, 2009. Defendant Ruspoli failed to answer and therefore default was entered against him on May 19, 2009.

2. The Complaint sought at least \$4,785,000.00 from Defendant Ruspoli plus interest of \$917.67/day from August 20, 2007 and therefore the amount sued for is a sum certain.
3. The total principal amount sued for is \$4,785,000.00 plus \$645,122.01 of interest accrued from August 20, 2007, the date of the Receiver's demand for the return of the funds, to July 23, 2009, the date of the Request for Default Judgment.
4. Plaintiff is also entitled to \$70,660.59 [$\$917.67 \times$ number of days], representing the amount of interest accrued from July 23, 2009, the date of the Request for Default Judgment, to the date of this Order.
5. There is no just reason for delaying the entry of a final judgment as to Defendant Ruspoli and as to the claims against him.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed that a default judgment be entered against Defendant Ruspoli for \$5,500,782.60 [$\$4,785,000.00 + \$645,122.01$, accrued interest as of July 23, 2009, the date of the Request] + [interest accrued from July 23, 2009 to the date of this Order]. It is further ordered that interest shall accrue on this judgment at the maximum rate allowed by law, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961.
